



**Merrion Cricket Club**  
**GDPR: Privacy Statement**  
**January 2021**

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Merrion are currently working on a more detailed Privacy Statement for the club to ensure compliance with GDPR. In the interim the following principles are being followed by the Club.

Data            The Club collects the minimum amount of personal information on members required for operational reasons. The personal data collected consists of Name and Address, Contact Numbers [phone and e/mail] and in the event members add children to their membership their names, gender and date of birth.

The club does not collect any financial information beyond confirmation of the date and amounts paid for membership subscriptions.

Collection:        The data is mainly collected online on club website but also from physical application forms for member and renewal receipts. Applications collected online are acknowledged.

Usage            The data is used to contact members, to process memberships, to record player statistics, to record the provision of services [e.g. attendance at summer camps, purchase of gear] and to identify role within club [e.g. what committees served on].

Storage:        The data is maintained on computers of members of the club authorised to hold such details e.g. Secretary, Membership Secretary, Treasurer and Youth Administrator. A printed record of all club members is submitted to the District Court as part of the application for the Club bar Licence. No cookies are used by the Club to extract additional data. Standard analytics is available on the Club Website.

Marketing:        The data is not made available to third parties and is only used in respect of matters deemed of interest to club members.

Employees        Employee data for communication with the revenue Commissioners is maintained by Treasurer and Assistant Treasurers on a standard accounting package.

Deletion        In accordance with our membership policy, personal data is maintained for two years after membership has lapsed. Membership fully lapses for those who have not paid their subscription on the last

day of the year following when they last paid their membership fees. At this point all personal information is deleted except for the name of the person, their years as members of the club and their playing record.

The Data Protection Officer for the Club is the Membership Secretary.
